

Maine Residents Property Tax and Rent Refund “Circuitbreaker” Application

(for refunds of property tax assessed or rent paid during 2009)

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR A REFUND UP TO \$1,600 IF:

- You do not have a spouse or dependent(s) and your 2009 household income was \$64,950 or less; or
 - You have a spouse or dependent(s) and your 2009 household income was \$86,600 or less
- AND**
- Your 2009 property tax was more than 4% of your 2009 household income; or,
 - The rent you paid in 2009 was more than 20% of your 2009 household income.

NOTE: Low-income Seniors do not need to meet these requirements.

Applications must be filed by May 31, 2011.
